1	VLADISLAV VIRIC (Head Coach of Dreams FC)	MISCONDUCT	<p>After the match between Asante Kotoko SC and Dreams FC at Obuasi Len Clay Stadium, Vladislav Viric made comments to wit that <i>'they called some people to help them, they are in black, you know, to help them to be better the game'</i>, a statement which in the opinion of the Association is likely to bring the game into disrepute.</p> <p>In his written statement of defence, Vladislav Viric pleaded guilty to the charge.</p>	Breach of Article 34(6)(d) of the GFA Premier League Regulations, 2019	<p>1. That Vladislav Viric is found guilty of the Charge.</p> <p>2. That a fine of GHc2,000 is hereby imposed on Vladislav Viric in accordance with Article 34.9 of the GFA Premier League Regulations and Article 6.1 of the GFA Disciplinary Code</p> <p>3. That Vladislav Viric, Head Coach of Dreams FC is hereby handed a one match suspension in accordance with Article 6(2)(a) of the GFA Disciplinary Code.</p> <p>4. That Vladislav Viric shall within three (3) days, publicly apologise to the Referees of the GFA and the entire Association, failing which Vladislav Viric shall serve a further 6 months ban.</p> <p>5. Vladislav Viric is warned that any future misconduct shall receive a more severe punishment.</p>
