

2	Great Olympics	<p>Accra Great Olympics FC was charged for a breach of Articles 1,2, 3 and 8 of the GFA Matchday Covid 19 Protocols.</p> <p>Accra Great Olympics FC was also hereby charged for a breach of Article 16(1) (b) and Article 16(2)(c) of the GFA Disciplinary Code, 2019.</p>	<p>Pleaded Not Guilty.</p> <p>The Club acknowledged that the protocols were breached but denied culpability. They argued that responsibility for maintaining security and orderliness had been passed to the GFA/Regional Authority based on a re-categorization by the GFA. The Disciplinary Committee disagrees and finds, to the contrary, that security always remains primary responsibility of the home team regardless of match category.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A fine of GHC 3000 is hereby imposed on Accra Great Olympics FC in accordance with Article 6 (1)(1) of the GFA Covid-19 Matchday Protocols 2.
