That the fine of GHc2,000 shall be paid to the GFA within 14 days failing which the GFA shall apply Article 15 of the Disciplinary Code.

The Club was also charged for breaching Article 1 and Article 3, of the GFA Matchday COVID 19 Protocols.  Kintampo FC failed to comply with the existing Matchday COVID 19 protocols put in place by the Ghana Football Association (GFA) and the Government of Ghana by allowing fans in the inner perimeter of the stadium to attack referees.  The Club also failed to ensure the safety of the match officials, as its supporters were seen invading the inner perimeter and threatening match officials.  Kintampo FC did fail to ensure law and order in and around the stadium as fans were seen invading field of play and did fail to prevent fans from invading the field of play	_
