1.	<b>SWEDRU ALL BLACKS UNITED FC.</b>	<p>Swedru All Blacks United FC is hereby charged for a breach of Article 16(2)(b) of the GFA Disciplinary Code, 2019.</p> <p>Description: On 23<sup>rd</sup> October, 2022, during the match between your club, Swedru All Blacks United FC and Future Stars FC at the Swedru Stadium, supporters of your club were seen throwing objects on the field of play, which resulted in hold up of play for about two minutes.</p>	<p>The Club pleaded Not Guilty to the charge and stated as follows:</p> <p>That the Club does not know whether their own supporters or the away team's supporters were the ones involved in the throwing of objects on the park but calm was quickly restored.</p> <p>The Club further apologized to the FA and indicated that they are always in talks with their supporters not to misbehave at the stadium.</p>	<p>The Disciplinary Committee finds that Swedru All Blacks United FC breached Article 16(2)(b) of the GFA Disciplinary Code.</p> <p><b>The Committee hereby makes the following decisions:</b></p> <p><b>1. SWEDRU ALL BLACKS UNITED FC is fined an amount of Three Thousand Ghana Cedis (GHc3,000.00).</b></p> <p><b>2. SWEDRU ALL BLACKS UNITED FC is warned that any future misconduct may result in a more severe punishment.</b></p>
