

# Ghana Football Association

Dear Sir/Madam,

Media accreditation for the FIFA World Cup 2026™ will open on 26 January 2026. As in previous editions of the tournament, FIFA member associations have each been allocated a fixed quota of written press and photographer accreditations.

Each member association is responsible for determining which national media organisations or media representatives will receive accreditation, as well as the number of press and photographer accreditations allocated to each organisation.

The accreditation quota that has been allocated to your association is listed below:

<b>Written Press:</b>	<b>10</b>
<b>Photographer:</b>	<b>2</b>

## Quota Management System (QMS)

Member associations will use the Quota Management System (QMS) to assign and distribute written press and photographer accreditations, in the form of control keys, to their national media organisations.

A dedicated section for each member association has been created within the QMS, and the FIFA World Cup™ written press and photographer accreditation quota has already been credited to each account.

Access to the QMS requires an approved individual FIFA Media Hub account. Each member association is requested to contact [mediaquota@fifa.org](mailto:mediaquota@fifa.org) and provide the Media Hub username (FIFA digital ID or email address) of the person or persons authorised to assign and distribute media accreditation quotas.

A QMS user manual is available and provides detailed guidance on how to use the system. Associations are requested to review the instructions carefully. The manual is available in Arabic, English, French and Spanish.
